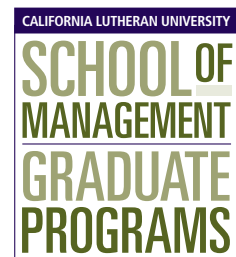


FULL TIME MBA IN SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA

“CLU is a Highly-Ranked University Offering an Accelerated Full-Time MBA in Southern California”

About the MBA Program

- A complete MBA can be completed in as few as 12 months (Students may choose to take 15, 18, 21, or 24 months)
- Four entry points per year (late August, mid November, late February, and mid May)
- US and International Students take classes together; Class size is never more than 30 students
- Work experience is not required
- GMAT is usually waived
- Conditional admission available
 - TOEFL is waived for students who complete the highest level of an English program recognized by CLU
 - Many MBA applicants attend the ELS Language Center at CLU, one of over 50 ELS Language Centers on university campuses in the US: www.els.edu/thousandoaks
- Applicants whose bachelor degree is not in business may apply to the MBA program and will complete 3-4 additional courses
- Minimum time to complete MBA including Foundation is 15 months
- CLU has outstanding faculty, all with business experience and most with substantial international experience
- CLU has one of the largest MBA programs in Southern California
- The program includes 12 core classes and 3 elective classes (15 total classes)
 - Students may choose a general MBA or an MBA in Finance, Marketing, Entrepreneurship, International Business, Information Technology, Management/Organization Behavior, Sustainable Business or Arts Management & Administration.



About the University

- California Lutheran University is ranked as a Top 20 Masters-Granting University in the Western United States by the publication *“U.S. News & World Report”*
- The MBA program is ranked as a TOP MBA in North America by QS, sponsor of the World MBA Tour
- CLU is highly ranked by the prestigious business publication, *“Forbes”*
- It is one of 28 universities and colleges operated by the Lutheran church in America
 - Faculty and students represent many diverse religions, beliefs, races, and ethnic backgrounds
- CLU was established over 50 years ago and has awarded MBA degrees for over 35 years; the Full-Time MBA is more than 10 years old
- The beautiful and modern CLU campus is on 200+ park-like acres (more than 90 hectares)

About the Community

- Thousand Oaks, California, is located between Los Angeles and Santa Barbara (about one hour from each)
- The FBI consistently ranks Thousand Oaks as one of the safest cities in the US
- The weather is near perfect – it is never too hot or too cold, and flowers bloom all year in the gentle climate

Cost of an MBA at CLU

- The costs for the MBA program for the 2012-2013 year include:
 - Tuition of approximately \$33,750 (includes tuition for 4 terms – the complete MBA)
 - Estimated books, fees (including mandatory health insurance), food, and laundry, etc. of about \$7,900
 - MBA Housing costs for 12 months of about \$9,000 (off-campus) or \$13,180 (on-campus)
- To obtain a student visa in 2012, the US government requires certification available resources of \$ 49,475
- There are NO scholarships, loans, assistantships, or any other forms of financial aid – domestic and international students pay the same price

CLU works with professional education counseling agencies. CLU offers rolling admissions with fast admissions decisions and four entry points per year

- Potential applicants are strongly encouraged to work through professional educational counseling agents

To apply to the MBA at CLU:

- A GPA of 2.8 is preferred, though some exceptions exist. We ask for bachelor transcripts, student statement of purpose, 2 recommendation letters, financial statement, and an application fee.
